The OEA Advocacy and Organizing Institute is scheduled for February 7-9, 2019 at The Crowne Plaza Columbus North Worthington, 6500 Doubletree Ave., Columbus, Ohio 43229.

Eighty (80) general scholarships of \$100.00 to attend the conference will be awarded to individuals from across the state local associations. Inclusive of those eighty (80) will be eight (8) Educational Support Professional (ESP) scholarships. Those awards will cover the full cost of the conference including mileage to and from the conference, meals not covered by the conference and the reimbursement of the local school district for a substitute on the Friday of the conference. Preference for all scholarships will be given to individuals attending the conference for the first time.

**Scholarship Guidelines:**

- ***The deadline for scholarship application is Friday, December 14, 2018. Please note that no applications will be accepted past the deadline.***
- The general scholarships will cover the registration cost for the conference which includes an overnight room (***based on double occupancy***) for Thursday and Friday, and meals provided at the conference. The recipient will be responsible for all other expenses incurred.
- The ESP scholarships cover round trip-mileage by automobile to and from the conference, conference registration, overnight room (***based on double occupancy***) for Thursday and Friday, meals not covered by the conference and substitute reimbursement to the participant's school district if needed. Meals will be governed by OEA Governance Expense Policy with amounts not to exceed \$8 for breakfast, \$12.00 for lunch and \$26.00 for dinner. Allowance will be made for up to 7.6% tax and 20% tip added to the meals.
- Scholarships will be awarded first to those who have never attended the Collective Bargaining Conference, and then in the order received with preference given to distributing scholarships throughout the geographic/district areas. If there are more applicants than scholarships, a waiting list will be maintained should there be a cancellation prior to the deadline.
- If a scholarship recipient would like single occupancy for the hotel, the individual will be responsible for **\$116.33** for the two (2) night stay. If the choice is to only stay one (1) evening, recipient will be responsible for **\$58.17**.
- ***You will be notified via email by Wednesday, January 2, 2019 if you are a scholarship recipient.*** It is the responsibility of each scholarship recipient to register online for the conference in accordance with the information provided in the notification email. If you wish to register prior to January 2, 2019 to ensure you get into the session(s) you would like to attend, ***please indicate that you will pay by check so OEA will not be responsible for sending a refund for your registration if you are a scholarship recipient.*** The registration website is <http://aoi.ohea.org> Registration and housing deadline is January 20, 2019.
- Please note that your District may also be offering scholarships for the conference. Contact your District directly for more information. ***No duplicate scholarships will be awarded.***
